

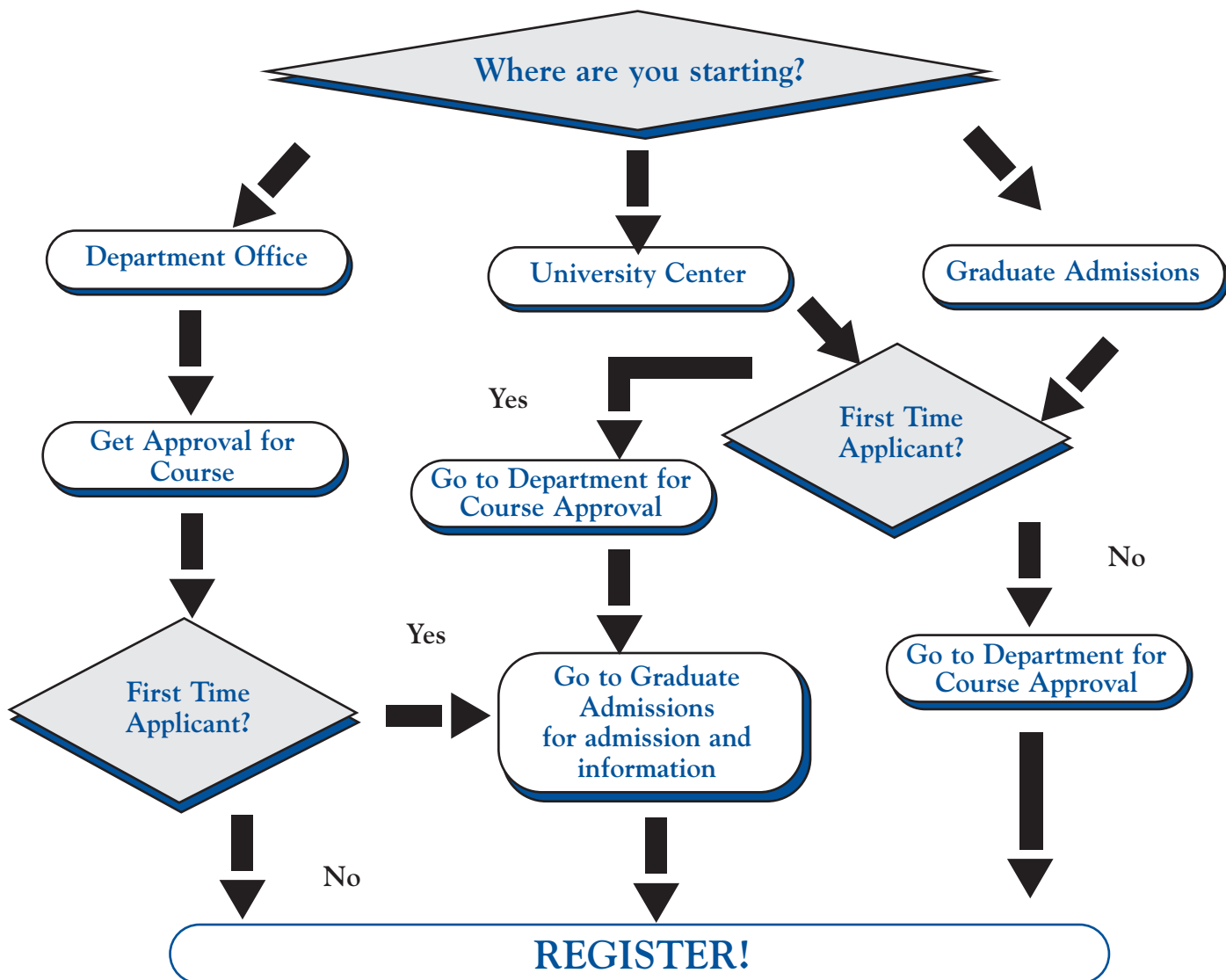

GRADUATE NON-DEGREE APPLICATION PROCEDURES



Graduate Non-Degree Studies at UAHuntsville (as approved by the UAHuntsville Graduate Council)

Students who are interested in earning graduate credit but who are not applicants for a graduate degree or certificate at UAHuntsville may be admitted as non-degree graduate students. (This category is not available to students on F-1 visas). Admission in this category varies by college and requires departmental approval.

All courses taken as “non-degree” require approval of the department. Students must maintain the same grade point average requirements expected of conditionally admitted graduate students. Graduate courses numbered 500 and above may be taken while in this category provided all prerequisites have been met.

Individuals admitted as graduate non-degree students may, at some point, decide to make formal application to a graduate degree or certificate program. If admitted, credit earned as a non-degree graduate student may be applied toward a graduate degree or certificate program subject to the following conditions and limitations:

- ❖ No more than twelve (12) graduate credit hours for courses taken as a non-degree student may be included in a degree program.
- ❖ All grades earned in 500 level courses or above during non-degree status must have been B or higher.
- ❖ Courses used to satisfy degree or certificate requirements are subject to approval by the major department and become a part of the student’s graduate GPA.

HOW TO BECOME A DEGREE-SEEKING STUDENT

1. Submit a graduate degree-seeking application form to the University of Alabama in Huntsville, Office of Graduate Admissions, 301 Sparkman Dr., Huntsville AL 35899.
2. Complete the request for one transcript from each college previously attended and have each school send transcripts directly to the Office of Graduate Admissions.
3. Comply with the test requirements as listed in detail on the Graduate Application form.
